

What is Show-Safe?

Show-Safe is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization that promotes a safe and thriving dog show environment that is free from abuse and misconduct for everyone in our shared community. Our core values are integrity, respect, safety, advocacy, and collaboration.

What Services Does Show-Safe Provide?

Education: Throughout 2025, we begin providing direct support to juniors, adults and clubs through no-cost education programs designed to prevent abuse and misconduct. Both in person and online options will aid in providing skills and best practices specific to the dog show environment.

Immediate Response Hotline: Our hotline, 1 (859)-203-8683, is available for anyone in the dog show community that does not currently feel safe. This confidential support mobilizes physical resources and information to help callers achieve safety wherever they are in the nation. We do comply with the mandatory reporting laws for child abuse and neglect, but we do not independently investigate or report incidents. We are happy to provide support for callers to do so themselves. No one needs to feel alone!

Aftercare: We work directly with those impacted by abuse and misconduct to facilitate trauma informed services and connections that support long-term healing.

Leadership Development: Our future Leadership Development program will create a pipeline of well-prepared, ethical leaders to sustain the values of Show-Safe across generations.
