If you're in a situation that doesn't feel safe our helpline is here to support you. Whether you're traveling with someone and feel uneasy or something happens at a show that leaves you unsure, our confidential, judgment-free helpline is here to help you feel safe and supported. No concern is too small.

Note: If you are in an emergency situation please call 911 or the Suicide & Crisis Lifeline at 988 for an emergency response. We are always here for follow up once your situation has stabilized.



When is the Helpline available?

You can call any time, day or night. If we're unable to answer immediately, leave a message with safe contact instructions, and we'll return your call as soon as possible. You're also welcome to try calling again later.

Who will answer?

Our helpline is answered by a small, trained team that follows strict confidentiality practices to protect your privacy and honor any boundaries you set.

What support is provided?

We'll help assess your situation and connect you with the support you need, such as mental health resources or safe lodging.
